1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") apply to all activities, workshops, and events ("Activities") organized by Stichting Pandora Studio ("Foundation"), a non-profit foundation established in The Netherlands. By registering for or participating in any Activity, participants agree to be bound by these Terms.

2. Purpose of the Foundation

Stichting Pandora Studio is a non-profit organization with the aim of promoting cultural exchange, community engagement, and creative expression through accessible, amateur-led events, workshops, and performances.

3. Participation and Registration

- Participation is open to all individuals above 18 years old unless otherwise specified in the activities description.
 - Some Activities may require prior registration due to limited capacity.
 - Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

4. Fees and Donations

- **Courses and workshops** require a **one-time payment** upon registration. **These fees are non-refundable**, even in case of cancellation by the participant.
- **Monthly activities** (e.g. regular classes) are billed on the **2nd day of each month**.
- To **cancel or pause a monthly subscription**, participants must notify Stichting Pandora Studio **at least 15 days before** the start of the next month by sending an email to: hello@pandorastudio.nl.
- Some other cultural events may be free of charge or donation-based.
- All proceeds support the Foundation's ongoing operations and programming.

5. Cancellations and Changes

- The Foundation reserves the right to cancel or reschedule an Activity due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g. illness, low registration numbers, force majeure).
- Participants will be notified as soon as possible in case of changes or cancellations.
- Where applicable, paid fees may be refunded or applied to a future Activity **only if the cancellation is initiated by the Foundation.**

6. Code of Conduct

- All participants are expected to behave respectfully and inclusively toward others.
- Discrimination, harassment, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- The Foundation reserves the right to refuse or remove participants who violate this code without a refund.

7. Liability

- Participation is at one's own risk.
- The Foundation and its staff are not liable for personal injuries, loss, theft, or damage of personal belongings during Activities, unless caused by gross negligence or intent.
- Participants are encouraged to have their own personal accident or liability insurance.

8. Media and Privacy

- During events, photos or videos may be taken for promotional purposes. These images may be used for promotional, marketing, and informational purposes, including:
 - The Stichting Pandora Studio website.
 - Social media channels
 - Printed materials (flyers, posters, newsletters, pictures in the studio)
 - Press releases and media coverage
 - You will not receive any payment or compensation for the use of these images or videos.
 - You can withdraw your consent at any time by contacting Stichting Pandora Studio at **hello@pandorastudio.nl**. Withdrawal will not affect the legality of prior use.
